# Lower School, Grades 1-4

At Tenafly Chabad Academy, our lower school program for grades 1-4 is designed to provide a nurturing environment that prepares our students for a lifetime of learning and success. With the guidance of our dedicated faculty and administration, students learn to organize, prioritize, and manage their own learning, developing the core academic skills in Torah learning, literacy, numeracy, science, technology, and the arts that will serve as the foundation for advanced studies as they grow. Our literacy curriculum uses a multi-sensory, direct-instruction method to build solid reading and writing skills. Our writing curriculum follows a structured program that helps students develop effective written communication skills. We follow the New Jersey Standards for English, Math, Science and Social Studies in each grade, incorporating hands-on inquiry based learning to develop an appreciation and understanding of Earth Science, Physics, life science and chemistry. In addition to academic skills, we prioritize executive functioning skills and social-emotional development in our lower school program. Our teachers collaborate closely with our school social-worker to develop and implement lessons and activities and to cultivate an appreciation for kindness, empathy, resilience and teamwork. We nurture the hearts and minds of all our students.









## Middle School, Grades 5-8

At Tenafly Chabad Academy Middle School, we are dedicated to the academic and personal growth and excellence of every child. We provide our students with an exceptional well-rounded education that prepares them for high school and beyond. Our experienced and passionate faculty and staff foster a nurturing and supportive environment where every student can flourish academically, emotionally, and spiritually.

Our comprehensive core curriculum and speciality classes are taught by professional and passionate educators who are experts in their fields of instruction. Whether the children sit in Language Arts, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Social Studies, Chumash, Navi, Halacha, Hebrew Language, Gemara, Coding, Robotics, Computer Science, Chess, Art, or Physical Education classes - they are pushed to stretch their minds and rise up to the challenge. Each lesson fosters critical thinking skills, collaboration, creativity, work ethic, and love for learning.

We place a strong emphasis on developing our students' emotional intelligence, confidence, empathy, and character through social-emotional activities and experiential learning opportunities such as Chesed activities, Bnei Mitzvah Club, pre-Shabbat onegs and celebrations of the chagim and Rosh Chodesh. Our goal is to empower our students to become kind, compassionate, and resilient individuals who are wellprepared to gracefully and confidently navigate the challenges of high school and life in general.







Above all, we celebrate the uniqueness of each student and strive to help them realize their full potential by providing personalized attention and support. By creating a warm and inclusive community, we foster a sense of belonging that helps our students feel valued and empowered to make meaningful contributions to the world around them. # iPrograms!

We are excited to offer two distinct academic support programs that cater to the diverse learning needs of our students. The iCan! Program is a comprehensive, personalized learning program that addresses fundamental skill gaps across various subjects. With fourteen support periods per week, iCan! students receive one-on-one instruction in ELA, math, and executive functioning skills such as organization and time-management. This intensive program replaces core subjects and ensures that students gain proficiency and readiness in the subjects they need most.

The iWill! Program is designed for Middle School students who require additional support to meet the demands of their coursework. Daily smallgroup sessions with a learning center specialist help reinforce ELA skills, including reading comprehension, writing, and language skills. Students also receive guidance in organization and study skills. Please note that enrollment in both programs is highly limited, and admission is on a first-come, firstserved basis, given the personalized attention each student receives.

## **STEM** (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)

STEM education is a vital part of our curriculum at Tenafly Chabad Academy, providing our students with the skills and knowledge necessary to succeed in an ever-evolving technological world. We believe that by integrating STEM into every classroom and providing dedicated STEM classes for every grade from 1st through 8th, we are preparing our students to be leaders in the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math.

In our Middle School, our students use their technological skills in every classroom in addition to our biweekly STEM and Computer science classes which provide a comprehensive approach to STEM education. Our students are given their own Chromebook for the year and learn physical computing using Arduino and robotics kits. They participate in Challenges in Engineering and explore coding languages such as block coding, JAVA Script and Python. They also learn about Digital Citizenship and Safety, develop advanced skills in Google programs, and delve into 3D modeling, graphic design, and multimedia production including Stop Motion and video creation.

In our Lower School, our students develop a strong foundation in STEM subjects, including proficiency in Google programs, keyboarding, coding, computational thinking, digital citizenship and safety, and robotics. These skills provide a solid foundation for their future academic and professional success.

Our STEM program is designed to complement and enhance our school's existing science program, ensuring that our students receive a well-rounded education in all STEM subjects. By offering a comprehensive STEM curriculum, we are preparing our students to be leaders in their future careers, equipped with the skills and knowledge to make a positive impact on the world.









### After School Extracurricular Activities/ Chugim
